



2019 Sudanese Revolution


- December 2018 Protests begin "the Bread Protests"
- January 2019
- February universities closed; reopen in fall 2019
- 7-8 March marches to honor women involved in protests
- 11 April al-Bashir deposed
- May-June ongoing protests and negotiations with TMC
- 3 June "The Darkest Day"
- July Political Agreement signed
- August Draft Constitution Declaration signed by FCC and TMC
- Nemat Abdullah Khair named Chief Justice
- Abdalla Hamdok named PM
 - 14 civilian ministers appointed including female foreign minister and a Coptic Christian

الشهادة الثانوية Sudan School Certificate


• Students who achieve a mark of 50% or above in at least five subjects in their Sudan School Certificate are eligible for higher education. The percentage mark is calculated from the four compulsory subjects plus the three highest optional subjects.


The certificate is awarded if:

- Student passes the four compulsory subjects (Arabic, English, mathematics and religion) plus one optional subject. Under this condition the range 80-100 is considered excellent and 70-79 is considered very good, or
- Student passes three compulsory subjects (including Arabic language) plus two or more optional ones."








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


Tertiary non-degree

 - All diplomas and degrees issued by national higher education establishments in Sudan are required to be authenticated at Ministry of Higher Education and information thereafter to be included in Ministry's database.
- Grades can be word descriptors (Excellent, Very Good, Good, Pass, Fail; others) letter grades, percentages check transcript, and varies by faculty




Alternative Learning System (AES)


Non-formal, provides opportunities to those who have dropped out of the formal system, or never attended
