DETECTING FRAUDULENT CREDENTIALS / INTERNATIONAL

Part I: Checklist for detecting fraudulent documents

A. Type and print elements

1. Are type or print elements uniform in size, shape, darkness?
2. Does name or other information slant in a different direction from other writing on the document?
3. Are the identifying entries, such as name, date of birth, place of birth, enrollment number, and national identification number(s), aligned with other writing on the document?
4. Are the academic entries, such as subjects, grades, dates of study, dates of exams, and hours per week, aligned with other writing on document?

B. Document status

1. When the original document is held up to the light, do you see alterations or erasures?
2. Has correction fluid/tape been used on the document?
3. Are there hand-written additions?
4. If unattested photocopies were submitted along with the original, do the copies match the original?
5. If the document was copied and then attested by the institution, does the attestation look authentic?



6. If a notarized photocopy is submitted, does the notary state that he examined the photocopy and compared it to the original, or does he merely state that the student came before the notary and swore that the photocopy was a true copy of a document?

7. Whether original, unattested photocopy, or attested photocopy, are there smudges / stains / burn marks / tears which prevent the reading of the name or other identifying information?

C. Photograph, names and dates

1. If a photograph is attached, is sealed by the institution and appropriate age / gender / race / for the applicant?

2. Is the name visible?

3. Are name changes, such as maiden to married name, documented?

4. Are the date and place of birth the same as those written on the institutional application? On other documentation? If not, is there an official correction?

5. Is the date of birth reasonable for the number of years of study?

6. Does the date of issue predate the information on the documents(s)?

7. Are dates in the standard international style of day + month + year?

8. Does the documentation indicate sufficient time to cover the prevailing degree plan? If not, is there proof of transfer from a prior institution?

D. Official paper

1. Is the document on official paper, such as sealed paper, or letterhead rather than on plain paper or computer paper?

2. Can you discern if a color printer was used? When you run your fingers across signatures and seals, is the paper raised or flat?



3. Are the logo, emblem, and letterhead consistent with those usually seen from the source institution?
4. Do the fiscal stamps on the document look authentic or like postage stamps?
5. Are the proper signatures, ink stamp seals, and dry seals affixed to the document?
6. Does the document look computer-generated?

E. Document handling

1. Was the document received by mail or was it hand-delivered?
2. Was the envelope handled by a third party such as a friend, a third country, an express-mail service, a courier or a delivery service? If the document was received by the latter, can the service confirm the actual pick-up location as opposed to the location entered on the shipping label?
3. Does the envelope bear an institutional logo and/or imprinted return address rather than a typed or hand-written return address?
4. Does the envelope bear metered postage rather than a postage stamp?
5. Do the postage and return address coincide with country of document origin?
6. If there is an annotation indicating that the document is confidential and should not be released to the student, was the document mailed directly to you by the institution?

F. Institution status

1. Can you locate the institution in standard reference resources on accredited international institutions (see list of suggested resources)?
2. Can you locate the institution in lists of degree mills and unrecognized international institutions or lists of unrecognized accreditors (see list of suggested resources)?



G. Document contents

1. Are the contents, such as subject codes, course names, grade scale, and course loads, consistent with what is usually seen from the source institution?
2. Is the academic calendar consistent with what is usually seen from the source institution?
3. Do institutional resources confirm that the institution offered the degree in question at the time under consideration?
4. Does the documentation place the student in two locations at the same time?

H. External evaluation

1. If you use a credentials evaluation service, does the evaluation conform to the service's usual format or wording?
2. Do the documents submitted by the student match those listed in or attached to the credentials evaluation?
3. Did you receive the original evaluation directly from the service?

I. Student interview

1. Does the student speak for himself or does he let someone else talk for him? Does the student seem unsure of his information?
2. Does an interview indicate that the student has the depth of knowledge or mastery of coursework, including English, indicated on his documents?
3. Does the student or his representative try to rush you into making an admissions decision?
4. Does the student or his representative try to tell you that his institution is no longer operational? That the institution won't answer your inquiries?

The Second Edition of *Chinese Universities and Colleges* is compiled and produced as part of the ongoing commitment of Chinese Education Association for International Exchange to enhancing educational exchange and cooperation between China and other countries and regions. It is intended mainly for foreign readers interested in understanding contemporary Chinese higher education, and particularly for those who are concerned about teaching or studying in Chinese colleges and universities.

This new edition contains listings for more than 1,062 higher education institutions nationwide (not yet including those in Taiwan Province) officially recognized by the State Education Commission of the PRC early in 1993. - Group F (Elective Group): The brackets are missing.
- The signatory is the *Controller of Examinations*, not *Examination*.

Diploma:

- The font is wrong for *Faculty of Commerce* below the emblem.
- First line of the descriptive paragraph: *University of Kerala* is in the wrong font. The word *the* is missing before the *University of Kerala*.
- First two lines of the descriptive paragraph: The word *that* belongs on line one of the text.
- The Roman numerals *I, II, III* are too large.
- The date of issue lacks the month written out in script.

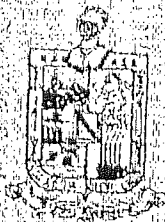

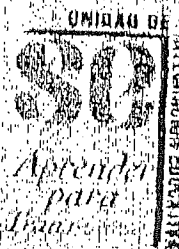
